ThromboGenics is developing Microplasmin as a non-surgical treatment for focal vitreomacular adhesion (or traction), a condition in which the vitreous gel has an abnormally strong adhesion to the retina.

It is the intention of Thrombogenics to become a fully integrated company focusing on the commercialisation of Microplasmin in eye diseases as well as the development of innovative medicines for the treatment of vascular diseases and cancer.

The candidate (m/f) will be responsible for program management components across multiple functional areas.
